We would all like to live in peace with our neighbours, but unfortunately that is sometimes not how things work out.

The Parish Council have no powers to be able to intervene in neighbour disputes.

Our policy is as follows;

- We encourage people to try and resolve issues amicably between themselves.
- Where this doesn't work and people feel that they need further help we can guide them to organisations that may be able to help them
- We cannot become involved at any level other than this.
- We must remember at all times that we are not enabled or skilled to get involved at any other level.
